














**Read the passage and answer the following questions.**

When we communicate with others, we express our thoughts and feelings not only through the words we choose, but also through our tone of voice, facial expression and body language. In fact, many communication experts believe that far more information is communicated non-verbally (without words) than verbally (with words). "Body language" is an important part of non-verbal communication. Body language includes many different aspects of our everyday physical behavior; the way we greet one another; how we stand, how we sit or walk; the way we position our arms and legs or use our hands and eyes are some of the most basic. To learn another language is more than just learning words and grammar, it involves learning about another culture, too. We learn much of our own culture's body language before we learn to speak, from the time we are children, usually without even being aware of (knowing) it. And that body language varies from culture to culture, so it's something to which second language learners should pay attention. Sometimes, cultural differences in appropriate body language can cause discomfort or misunderstandings too." Even speakers of the same language, such as British, American, or Australian people, may not use the same body language. British people are said to be more reserved and formal, in general, and this is reflected in their body language. Americans are considered more open and outgoing, while Australians are seen as casual and relaxed.
